Northern Shrike	1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Many large bull elk, cows (females) and calves on National Elk Refuge • Bald eagle perched and flying in Grand Teton National Park • N. Shrike hunting in sage flats (predatory songbird also referred to as "butcherbird" for its ruthless predatory behavior) • Many moose including very large bulls foraging on bitterbrush near Kelly, WY (Grand Teton NP)
